



## What will Proposition 19 do for California?

- **Limits Property Taxes for Vulnerable Californians.** Prop. 19 removes unfair location restrictions so that seniors, people with disabilities, and wildfire victims can move closer to family or medical care, or replace a damaged home without a property tax increase.
- **Will Generate 67,000 to 150,000 Transactions Per Year.** Starting in 2021, Prop. 19 will generate a significant increase in annual home sales of at least 67,000 transactions per year and will grow to 150,000 new home transactions per year over the next few decades.
- **Eliminates Unfair Restrictions on Homeowners.** Prop. 19 provides tax savings and provides portability benefits for millions of homeowners. It eliminates home value restrictions to allow transfers on more expensive homes and lifts the existing single-transfer limit to allow up to three tax base transfers.
- Dedicated Funding for Life Saving Fire and Emergency Response. Creates a historic Fire Response Fund to provide dedicated funding for wildfire response across California, protecting millions of homes and lives.
- **Tax Relief for California's Family Farms.** Protects family-owned farms by limiting property taxes parents pass the family farm to their children.
